### Types of blood tests:

1. **Capillary Test**  
Finger or heel-prick that provides quick results
2. **Venous Blood Draw**  
Blood draw that provides accurate results, but takes a couple days

### Testing home for lead:

1. Lead-Safe Home Remediation Program  
Educational program for New Jersey residents and free lead testing for eligible residents
2. Isles Lead Testing  
Offers free testing for residents and if lead is found, free repairs could be made (if income does not exceed limit)
3. Lead Remediation and Abatement Program  
Federally-funded program eligible to low-to-moderate tenants (with incomes not exceeding 80% of Area Median Income), living in 1-4 unit properties built before 1978
